BACKGROUND

Robert Koch, co-founder of Fugleberg Koch, has offered industry architectural leadership through participation in professional associations, civic organizations, and industry educational forums for more than a half century. Together with Joanne, his wife, they oversaw public messaging of "lessons learned" via a white paper program that has earned acknowledgement as valued references in the housing and hospitality industries. In honor of their commitment to professional learning and sharing, this tribute is offered.

The purpose of the Robert and Joanne Koch Scholarship for Architecture is to provide financial assistance to an exceptional student who is pursuing a bachelor's degree in architecture at an accredited college within Florida.

The Robert and Joanne Koch Scholarship for Architecture will provide one (1) scholarship to a graduating high school senior in the amount of \$1,000, payable in one (1) installment. Student must be a graduating senior student from one of the following three Central Florida counties: Orange, Osceola, or Seminole. The scholarship will be awarded based on merit. Award can be applied to tuition, board, and/or other mandatory educational fees. Awards will be made payable to the educational institution only. Only students who have already been accepted into an educational institution are eligible to apply. If you have not yet been accepted to a college or university, please do not apply at this time.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SYNOPSIS:

- 1. The Robert and Joanne Koch Scholarship for Architecture will provide one (1) award, which will be \$1,000 to a graduating high school senior enrolled in the first year of an accredited architectural program at a school of architecture within Florida (i.e. 2+2+2 program (Valencia College + UCF + UF), Florida State, Florida A&M, University of Miami, etc...), or first year acceptance to the University of Florida's School of Architecture in the College of Design, Construction, and Planning.
- 2. Student shall have a permanent legal family address in either Orange, Osceola, or Seminole County, Florida.
- 3. Scholarship is merit based.
- 4. Unweighted GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- 5. Copy of the standardized test scores from the College Board or ACT account.
- 6. Write a short essay of 1,000 words or less indicating how you intend to make a difference in our world with a degree in architecture.
- 7. 2 letters of recommendation required.
- 8. Scholarship award will be made payable to the recipient's educational institution.
